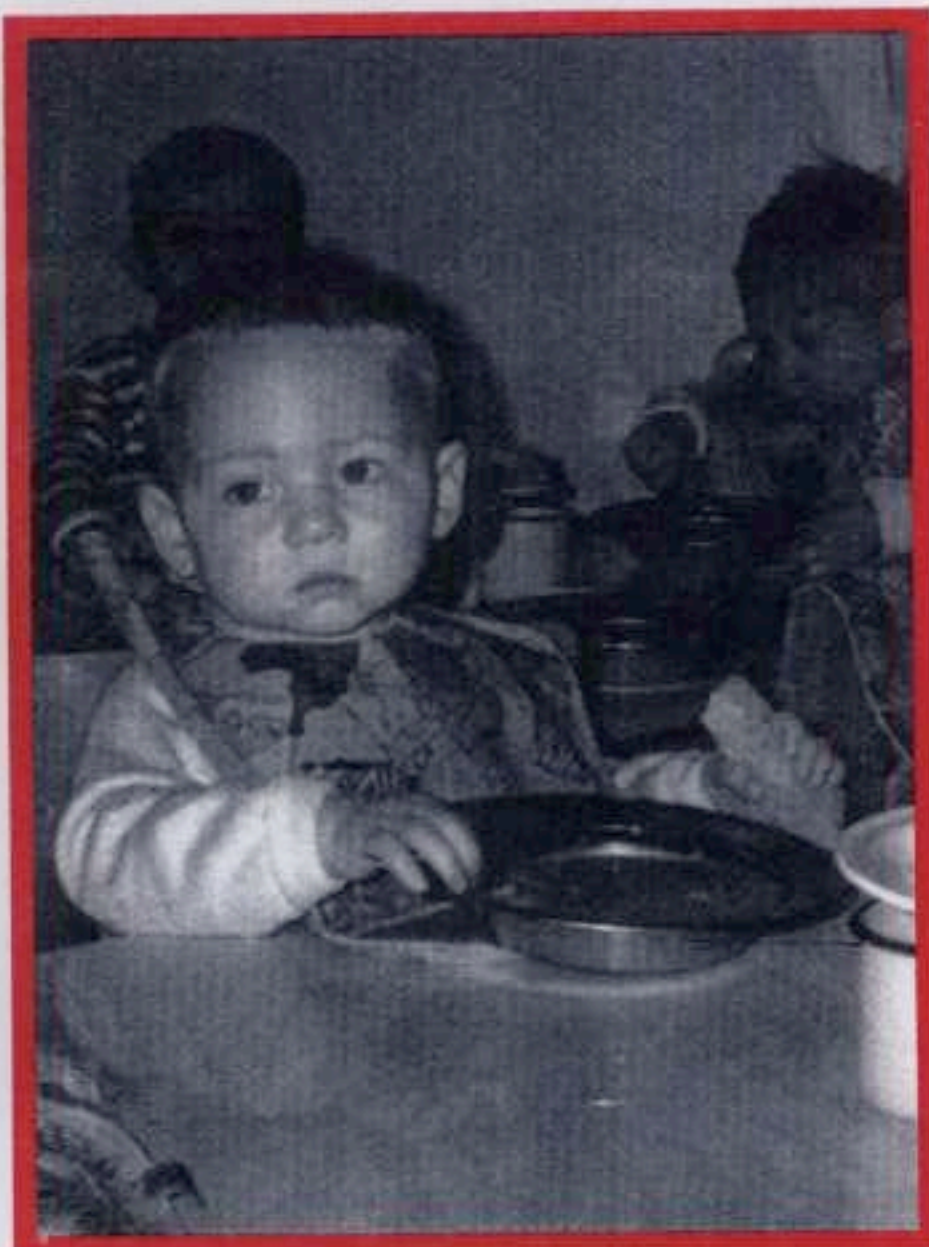

HELP US HELP THE CHILDREN, INC. is a voluntary non-profit charitable organization dedicated to improving conditions in children's institutions.

An estimated 174,000 children are living in Ukrainian orphanages. The children range in age from infants to 17 years.



The majority of the children are orphans; others were abandoned due to birth defects or because their parents were unable to support them.



Other children were placed in orphanages on court order, victims of domestic violence, crime or parental alcohol addiction.



In effect, the orphanages are becoming homes for children without parents and increasingly a social safety net for non-orphans.

HELP US HELP THE CHILDREN, INC. is to provide aid to these children's institutions, which lack even basic supplies and support.



HELP US HELP THE CHILDREN, INC. is staffed by volunteers. Professionals from such fields as medicine, education, and finance, serve as advisors in policy formulation and project development. Among their numerous activities, volunteers:

- fund raise and organize special benefit events
- set up collection bins in stores, churches, financial institutions, and schools
- collect good quality gently used and donated clothing, toys and new shoes
- collect educational materials
- purchase any additional needed goods with donated funds
- package goods for shipment
- develop needs assessment profiles for each orphanage
- identify and prioritize essential medication supplies
- provide information on medication and formula use, translated into Ukrainian
- travel to Ukraine to personally distribute the supplies and monitor the inventory and proper use of previously donated goods
- reassess and update the needs of each institution at every visit
